KNOCKOUT RULES

- Round Robin for all teams on Saturday (3 games) with a Knockout system on the Sunday
- Each game will be 28 minutes duration, change ends after each touchdown
- All players must approved touch shoes while playing
- A points system will operate on Saturday with 3 points for a win, 2 points for a draw and 1 point for a loss
- The first touchdown in each match on both days except the Finals on Sunday is worth 3 points; the second and subsequent touchdowns are worth 2 points. Touchdowns in the Finals are worth 1 point. Draws on Sunday will be decided by the drop off system
- Any player sent off for the remainder of the game will receive an automatic one game suspension on either day unless the YTA's Judiciary believes otherwise
- All teams to be at the ground 5 minutes before the game is due to commence
- Each team plays at least 3 games on Saturday and at least 2 games on Sunday, if the repechage competition is held
- All decisions by the YTA's Carnival Disputes Committee are final
- The Grand Final will be 28 minutes duration. If both sides are scoreless at fulltime, the winner will be decided by the drop-off system
- The competition will be six-a-side
- Mixed teams must have the minimum of 3 female players on the field
- **Each team is required to nominate a qualified non-playing referee to participate in the Knockout-Playing Referees will NOT be allowed**
- A player can't play for more then one team in a division e.g Men's division.
