## Summary of Changes

New South Wales Touch Association wishes to advise the following important changes in the 2016 General Conditions for NSWTA events. Affiliates, Officials, Team Management & players should be aware of these changes when choosing to participate in NSWTA Events;

## Definitions

- Clause D: Unaffiliated
- Clause K: Like Competitions
- Clause L: Interstate Players

## Section 2: Responsibilities

- Clause 2.2.10: Uniform Requirements

## Section 3: Requirements

- Clause 3.1.1: Player Eligibility
- Clause 3.1.2: Player Eligibility & Registration
- Clause 3.1.3: Competition/Qualification
- Clause 3.1.10: Player Draft and restrictions
- Clause 3.1.18: Usage of "Interstate Players" by Affiliates and restrictions in Senior divisions and Junior Events of these.
- Clause 3.3.1: Player Point's System Definitions-particularly "Interstate Player - Is not eligible for home grown or long term player status unless they have declared that selection to NSWTA State of Origin as their first choice. Therefore a player who chooses not to represent NSWTA will be treated as a new import player year on year."
- Clause 3.3.2: State Rankings for Men's Open, Women's Open & Mixed Open
- Clause 3.3.3: Import Player Point's inclusion of Youth & 20's Divisions
- Clause 3.3.4: Import Points Table for Affiliate Spending
- Clause 3.3.6: Interstate Players are not eligible for home grown or long term status.
- Clause 3.3.10: Player Points Values Chart
- Clause 3.6.8: Referee Requirements and Development trust
- Clause 3.6.1.1: Nomination of minor Referees
