Subject: Representative Rankings-Opens Divisions

The 2016 Representative Season saw the changing of the guard with a number of movements with each of the respective grades. The rankings process is a detailed account on the performance of each club in their best two of three major events that NSWTA conduct. These include the Vawdon Cup, Country Championships and State Cup.

The official rankings have an impact on the ability for Affiliates to recruit. This information is detailed in the later stages of this Memorandum via the General Conditions of Entry.

#### So what do the rankings mean and how do they affect those clubs?

The Rankings system is designed to assist the NSWTA in both monitoring the development of Affiliate's at representative level as well as aiding in draw positions for events. Importantly they aid in the protection of the integrity of the competitions in ensuring that player strength is filtered throughout the various competing Club's in each competition through the Player Import Allowance;
