## SECTION 2: VAWDON CUP ENTRY INFORMATION

### 2.1 Nomination Closing Date

Affiliate Team, Referee & Team Management Nominations will be available via the [2019 Vawdon Cup Website](#) and is due by **Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2019**. Late nominations will only be accepted at the convenience of the competition.

All successfully nominated Affiliates will be required to provide their Team Rosters, Statutory Declaration, List of Un-financial/Suspended Players and Working With Children Protection Forms by **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2019**. All Team Management and Affiliate Coordinators will need to complete the online registration by **Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2019** via the [2019 Vawdon Cup Website](#).

Incomplete Team, Coach & Referee Nominations will be advised to Affiliates and only accepted when properly and fully completed.

### 2.2 Nominations & Entry Fees

There are a number of important details that are necessary for this process to be completed:

- Teams the Affiliate are entering into the competition
- Coaches, Assistant Coach & Managers details (Name, Mobile & Email).
- Qualified Referees for each team and details (Name, Mobile & Email), plus an additional one from your Affiliate (For Example: 2 teams = 3 Referees)

The individual player registration process will be via the [2019 Vawdon Cup Website](#) once the nominations have been confirmed by the NSWTA Events Coordinator.

The fees for the 2019 Vawdon Cup are as follows:

- Individual Players Registration: **\$88.31** per person due **Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2019**.
- Secondary Individual Player Registrations: **\$58.90** per person and can **only** be completed between **Monday 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 - Wednesday 25 September, 2019**. This is between the completion of round 5 and prior to the commencement of round 8 of the competition. Players must be registered by 5pm the Wednesday prior to the round they wish to begin participating in.
- Inclusion League Team Registrations: \$550 per team due **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2019**.

<b>2.6</b>	<b>Affiliate Coordinator &amp; Team Management Requirements</b>
	<p>Affiliate Coordinators and Team Management personnel must be members and registered within the NSWTA Affiliate they represent, in the current (S1 2019) or previous competition (S2 2018). In extenuating circumstances, Team Management may seek dispensation by placing their request in writing to the NSWTA prior to the Tournament by <b>Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2019</b>.</p> <p>Minimum accreditation required for the Vawdon Cup Team Management is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Premier League Head Coaches – TFA Elite (Level 3) Accreditation &amp; Play by the Rules.</li> <li>● Head Coaches – TFA Talent (Level 2) Accreditation &amp; Play by the Rules.</li> <li>● Assistant Coach – TFA Foundation (Level 1) Accreditation and Play by the Rules.</li> <li>● Manager – Play by the Rules - <a href="http://www.playbytherules.net.au/">http://www.playbytherules.net.au/</a></li> </ul> <p>It is a requirement that each Affiliate to keep adequate records of Team Management Accreditations including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Coaching Accreditation</li> <li>● Play by the Rules Certification</li> <li>● Working with Children Check Status (<b>N.B.</b> 2019 is the first year of renewals)</li> </ul>

<b>2.7</b>	<b>Referee Nomination</b>
	<p>The referee nomination must be completed as part of the team nomination process which is due on <b>Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2019.</b></p> <p>Affiliate Responsibilities of Referees Nomination:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Affiliates are required to <b>nominate as a minimum of one (1) referee per team</b> nominated <b>PLUS one (1) Extra Referee</b> (i.e. 3 teams = 4 Referees)</li> <li>• Nominated referees must be registered online in and officiating at the Affiliate they wish to represent in the current or previous season. <b>N.B.</b> Please refer to clause <b>3.6.4</b> of the General Conditions of Entry</li> <li>• Nominated referees must be of the standard of the Vawdon Cup competition</li> <li>• Nominated referees must have <b>at least 12 months</b> of practical refereeing experience before attending the 2019 Vawdon Cup</li> </ul> <p>Referee Responsibilities of Nomination:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be 16 years or older</li> <li>• Must have a minimum of <b>Level 2</b> Referees accreditation</li> <li>• In the rounds of the competition, officiate a <b>minimum of 5 Friday</b> evenings of the competition plus a <b>minimum of two Sunday</b> double headers</li> <li>• Must be available for the entire final series if selected by the NSWTA Referees Panel</li> <li>• Complete the individual referee’s registration by <b>Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2019.</b></li> </ul> <p>If the referee’s nomination is <b>not fully completed</b>, team nominations will be rejected. During the verification process, if a referee is unaware that they have been nominated by the Affiliate, the Affiliate’s team nominations will not be accepted.</p> <p>NSWTA are enforcing referee qualification and that referees must be participating in the competition/Affiliate they wish to represent. We acknowledge that NSWTA’s rules and regulations have not been sternly enforced enough in the past in relation to Referee movements compared to players. As such, the following process for 2019-20 Events will be implemented:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) All Referees will need to identify which is the main/home Affiliate which they register online via SportsTG and officiate regularly in-line with the seasonal eligibility requirements of the NSWTA Events Conditions of Entry. Validation of this information will be made by the individual Referee themselves via registration, the Affiliate Coordinator and Referees Director, the NSW State Referees Panel and the NSWTA.</li> <li>2) Once identified and confirmed by all, this will be the only Affiliate that the individual referee will be nominated by to participate in any NSWTA managed or endorsed event. Should a Referee wish to change their main/home Affiliate this will need to be validated by all parties listed as per Point 1.</li> </ol>

	<p>3) If an Affiliate has met their required Referees compliance and has excessive referees whom wish to participate at the event or they are not entering any teams, they will still be able to nominate such referee(s) for that event noting the below conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) These additional referees will be added to the NSWTA Pool who <u>could</u> be called upon to meet the shortfall of referees if loaned to another Affiliate to meet compliance;</li> <li>b) If called upon, these referees would be added as a loan to that Affiliate for that Event <u>only</u>. The non-compliant Affiliate will be fined \$800 per referee and paid via the closing date of Referees Registration for that Event. In each case, the fine would be redistributed with the loaned Referees main/home Affiliate being credited \$400. The remaining \$400 would be placed in trust with NSWTA and utilised for the non-compliant Affiliate's referee development plan over the following 12 months;</li> <li>c) If the event has meet compliance and has sufficient referees, then the Affiliate would still be able to have their Referee participate at the cost advertised in that particular Event's Conditions of Entry.</li> </ul> <p>4) If an Interstate/International referee wishes to participate, firstly they need endorsement from their relevant National or State Referees Panel/Director. They would also be loaned as per the advice in Point 3A. The reinvestment of the \$400 would not be to their interstate/international entity, but rather to the NSWTA Technical Development Program.</p> <p>5) In all cases, if the Pool of Referees was empty or exhausted, then the non-compliant Affiliate would not be able to participate until they were compliant with the NSW Touch Football Events Conditions of Entry.</p>
<b>2.8</b>	<b>Individual On-Line Registration</b>
	<p>The individual registration process will be open at the <a href="#">Vawdon Cup website</a> once the nominations have been confirmed by the NSWTA Events Coordinator.</p> <p>The fees for the 2019 Vawdon Cup are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Individual Player Registration: \$88.31</b> per person due <b>Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2019</b>. It is a requirement that all teams register a minimum of 14 participants per team to compete in the tournament. Late registrations requests will not be accepted due to a secondary registration window available.</li> <li>• <b>Secondary Individual Player Registration:</b> Teams may register additional players at the midway mark of the tournament. The cost will be <b>\$58.90</b> per person and can only be completed between <b>Monday 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 until Wednesday 25 September, 2019</b>. This is between the completion of round 5 and prior to the commencement of round 8 of the competition. Players must be registered by 5pm the Wednesday prior to the round they wish to participate in.</li> </ul> <p><b>Refunds:</b> Any team that registers more than 14 players and has players that have not participated in a single match will be in consideration for a full refund of registration. This must be via written correspondence to the Event Coordinator by <b>Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> October. No applications will be accepted after Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> October.</b></p>
<b>2.9</b>	<b>Team Numbers</b>
	<p><b>Teams may register an unlimited number of players but only use a maximum of fourteen (14) players</b> in a game. Any team found guilty of either using more than <b>fourteen (14) players</b> or using an unregistered player may be liable to be disqualified.</p>

	<p><b>N.B A player may only register in one (1) team. Also, a player may only participate in one (1) team per competition round.</b></p> <p>All teams and Affiliates that do not register the required 14 players for each team will be invoiced for the financial shortfall of players at \$88.31 per player to compensate for the 14 players required, this invoice will need to be paid prior to the first round of the 2019 Vawdon Cup on <b>Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2019.</b></p>
<b>2.10</b>	<b>Communication</b>
	<p>Each Affiliate <b>must</b> nominate an Affiliate Coordinator responsible for all correspondence and dealings with the NSWTA Events Coordinator. All communication with Affiliates and Teams will be made through the correct email address and mobile number provided.</p> <p>To further enhance the communication links, it is recommended that all Affiliate Coordinators, Team Management, Players and Referees utilise the NSW Touch smart phone free app. This is available via the Google Play Store &amp; Apple App Store.</p> <p><b>It is the responsibility of the Affiliate Coordinator to ensure Coaches, Managers and Referees are informed of any changes when notified by NSWTA and that they are conversant with these Conditions of Entry and the General Conditions of Entry for all NSWTA Events.</b></p>
<b>2.11</b>	<b>Affiliate Coordinators and Team Management Briefing</b>
	<p>NSWTA will provide an online video briefing at the <a href="#">Vawdon Cup website</a>. This briefing will be available from <b>Monday 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2019</b>. It is imperative that all Affiliate Coordinators and Team Management view the information as it is expected that all information within is understood.</p> <p><b>Enquiries for all teams must be made by the Affiliate Coordinator to NSWTA.</b> All correspondence from NSWTA will be sent to the Affiliate Coordinator and Team Management contacts via emails supplied by the Affiliate Coordinator.</p> <p>No responsibility will be taken for any actions undertaken by Team Management who do not view the video. Any questions out of this briefing should be directed to the Events Coordinator.</p>
<b>2.12</b>	<b>Youth League</b>
	To play in this competition, players must be born <b>between 2002 and 2006 inclusive.</b>
<b>2.13</b>	<b>Technical Assistance</b>
	Any Affiliate that wishes to obtain information about referee courses, please contact your Regional Referee Director or NSWTA Technical Administrator via <a href="mailto:technical@nswtouch.com.au">technical@nswtouch.com.au</a> .
<b>SECTION 3: EVENT OPERATIONS</b>	
<b>3.1</b>	<b>Control of the Event</b>
	The Event Coordinator in conjunction with the Sport Manager & General Manager will be in charge of all matters relating to the Tournament. Any matters not covered in the General Conditions or Tournament Conditions will be determined by the above Officials and their decision will be final.
<b>3.2</b>	<b>Wet Weather</b>
	On inclement weather days, field inspections will be conducted at <b>3.00pm</b> for Fridays and at <b>6:30am</b> for Sundays. All participants will be emailed and will receive a notification via the NSW Touch Smartphone App. Information will also be placed on the NSWTA Website as well as NSW Touch Football Facebook, Twitter and Instagram pages.
<b>3.3</b>	<b>Match Results</b>
	Match results will be updated on the NSW Touch Football Website at the completion of each competition round via the <a href="#">Vawdon Cup website</a> . Results can also be viewed from the “NSW Touch” FREE smart phone application.





<b>3.7</b>	<b>Trophies</b>
	<p>Awards will be presented to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Winners &amp; Runners Up Trophies</li> <li>• Medallions for the winners and runners up.</li> <li>• Affiliate Championship.</li> <li>• Gary Croft Cup – Affiliate Point Score</li> <li>• Lane Shields - for Minor Premiers in Men’s Premier League.</li> <li>• Neal Shields – for Minor Premiers in Women’s Premier League.</li> <li>• Russell / Gregory Shields - Minor Premiers in Mixed Division 1.</li> <li>• Finals Referees (Medallions only)</li> <li>• Player of the Final</li> <li>• Boland and Smith Medals for the Men’s and Women’s Premier League Divisions.</li> <li>• Michael Jonson Medal for Player of the Series in Men’s Masters.</li> </ul> <p><b>N.B.</b> Any Affiliate who does not supply the correct referee quota of referees will be ineligible for the Affiliate Championship.</p>
<b>3.8</b>	<b>Presentations</b>
	<p>All Presentations with the exception of the Boland &amp; Smith medals will be held on Grand Final Day on <b>Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2019.</b></p> <p>The Boland &amp; Smith Medals will be presented at the conclusion of the competition.</p>
<b>3.9</b>	<b>Draw Format</b>
	The final format will not be decided until all team nominations are received.
<b>3.10</b>	<b>Medical</b>
	<p>The Medical Team will comprise of <b>1 Sports Trainer at each venue.</b></p> <p>The Sports Trainer is able to provide preventive strapping at a cost.</p> <p>For insurance requirements, please report all injuries to the NSWTA Medical team and takeaway a copy of the incident report.</p>
<b>3.11</b>	<b>Movement of Players between Divisions</b>
	<p>Incumbent State (State of Origin 2018) or National (World Cup 2019) Open players may only participate in their Affiliate’s highest nominated division. They will not be eligible to move to lower divisions even in the case of a competition bye.</p> <p><b>N.B.</b> In extenuating circumstances Affiliates may be given leniency on this requirement once written correspondence is received by the Events Coordinator.</p> <p><b>N.B. Participants may only compete in <u>one (1) division</u> per competition round.</b></p>
<b>3.12</b>	<b>Finals Eligibility</b>
	<p>A player must have played a minimum of four (4) rounds to be eligible for the Finals Series. Any players not fulfilling the criteria due to extenuating circumstances must make written application to the Events Coordinator for consideration.</p> <p><b>Finals Qualification Criteria</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Must have participated in a minimum of four (4) games within the 2019 Vawdon Cup;</li> <li>2. Players must have played 50% or greater of their games in that division. For example, if a player has played 4 games in division 2 and 5 games in division 1 the player is only eligible for Division 1;</li> </ol>

	<p>3. If a player has played 4 games or more, but equally 50% in two categories they are eligible for both final series;</p> <p>4. If a player has qualified in a division, they are able to participate in higher divisions and still return to their original divisions without penalty.</p>
<b>3.13</b>	<b>Weekly Sign on Sheets</b>
	<p>The official NSWTA team sheet must be fully completed at the Tournament Control area at least <b>15 minutes prior</b> to the commencement of each game, indicating the registered players (maximum of 14) participating that match.</p> <p>Any player moving between divisions must be noted in the “player movement section” of the official NSWTA team sheet. If a team sheet(s) is not correctly submitted, requests will be made over the P.A system.</p> <p>The team sheets are to be signed by the coach or manager in front of the venue manager prior to the commencement of each match. These team sheets are <b>NOT</b> to be removed from the tournament control area.</p> <p>If a team is running late for a match for any reason, they must contact Tournament Control at the relevant venue or the NSWTA Events Coordinator immediately.</p>
<b>3.14</b>	<b>Rules, Variations &amp; Adjustments</b>
	<p>The NSWTA conduct events under the auspices of the Touch Football Australia 7<sup>th</sup> Edition rule book. This may be adjusted at a later time after the review of the Touch Football Australia 8<sup>th</sup> Edition rule book prior to the commencement of the event</p> <p>Please refer to NSWTA Rules, Variations &amp; Adjustments outlined as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Drop Off Procedure</b> – NSWTA utilises the Continuation rule in all drop off scenarios whereby play recommences at the same field position and continuing the touch count. This rule is explained in full detail under clause <b>12.2</b> in the General Conditions of Entry.</li> <li>• <b>Substitution and Sub Box</b> – All interchanges must occur on one side of the field and at or within the team’s interchange area only after a substituted player has crossed the sideline and entered the interchange area. This is explained in full detail under clause <b>12.3</b> in the General Conditions of Entry.</li> <li>• <b>Mutual Respect Policy</b> – All participating members of the 2019 Vawdon Cup (including Players, Coaches, Referees, Selectors, Officials and spectators), have an obligation to be conversant with this protocol and both the NSWTA and TFA Member Protection Policy. This is explained in full detail under clause <b>12.4</b> in the General Conditions of Entry.</li> <li>• <b>Interception Rule</b> – NSWTA will be continuing with an alteration to the intercept rule. On the change of position via an intercept, the first touch will be “<b>Zero touch</b>”.</li> </ul> <p><b>N.B.</b> These can also be found under <b>Section 12: Rules</b> within the General Conditions of Entry.</p>
<b>3.15</b>	<b>Send Offs &amp; Periods of Time</b>
	<p>Any player sent from the field for the remainder of the game will receive an automatic two (2) match suspension unless the Disciplinary Committee considers further action.</p> <p>Due to the length and style of the Vawdon Cup competition a five (5) match window will be in operation for repeat Period of Times. Should a player receive a Period of Time and not re-offend for the next five (5) matches he/she plays in, the first Period of Time given will lapse. However, an automatic one (1) match suspension will occur if a player is given two Periods of Time occur within the five (5) match window.</p>

For a player who receives a second period of time within the five (5) match window and is to serve a one (1) match suspension, this will be served in the division from which they received the second period of time.

These rules are explained in full detail under clauses **12.5**, **12.6** and **12.7** in the General Conditions of Entry.
