



## JUNIOR STATE CUP TENT SET UP INFORMATION – WAGGA WAGGA

It is important to note for first-timers and experienced participants alike the rules around vehicle access on site at the Jubilee Park Sports Complex precinct, especially throughout the weekend and for setting up pop-up style tents.

### Main Car Park Access (Bourke Street)

The main P1 car park with entry via Bourke Street will only be accessible with an official 2020 Junior State Cup P1 Bourke St car pass for the duration of the event. This car pass is provided from NSWTA to Affiliate Coordinators and not for sale.

Please note that for vehicles that do not have P1 car passes, there is to be **NO VEHICLE ACCESS** into the P1 car park outside of the designated times listed below.

### Tent Set Up Times

All affiliate tents will be located inside the Athletics Centre. To allow for tent set up and pack up in the Athletics Centre and also spectator tents in the designated areas around the event precinct, general vehicle access times throughout the weekend are as follows:

All unauthorised vehicles must be off-site outside of the above listed times.

### VENUE DRIVING CONDITIONS

- There is to be no unauthorised access on the Jubilee Park precinct or Conolly Park precinct prior to Thursday 4:00pm.
- Vehicles **CANNOT BE REVERSED** on site – ALL vehicles MUST enter and exit site moving in a forward direction ONLY.
- Vehicle speed limit is **5km/hr** (walking pace) and pedestrians have right of way at all times.
- There is **NO** vehicle access onto any of the playing fields.
