The NSW Government has announced a further easing of restrictions from Saturday 13 June, with food courts allowed to reopen, the number of people allowed to visit homes increased from 5 to 20, and the number of people allowed to gather outdoors increased from 10 to 20.

This announcement will enable Return to Train to expand to groups of 20 for outdoor, non-contact training activities, maintaining physical distancing from 13 June 2020.

Associations are reminded that until changes come into effect, they are required to comply with the current Public Health Order and follow the recommended physical distancing measures of 1.5 metres while training in groups of up to 10 people.
