S1 Competition and Affiliation

Currently no return to play date

Members and Participants health and safety must come first

Encourage all tradition S1 competitions to run when Government approval is provided

Even if in short form as a lead into the summer season





S1 Competition and Affiliation

For Season 1 Competitions yet to commence;

- NSWTA Board have signed off on an in-principle reduced fee structure for shortened competitions.
- Less than 6 rounds
- 6-10 rounds.
- These have been discussed positively with TFA and we are awaiting confirmation from them.
- When we have that confirmation, we will be able to provide the detail to all our affiliates.

For Season 1 Competitions currently in suspension

- This position is being discussed with TFA. NSWTA Board position if they can not resume will be around a flexible approach.





Return to Play Protocols

- The NSW Government and NSW Health have not provided advice on a return to play.
- The National Cabinet has released a National Reboot Framework for Community Sport and Sport Australia have released a Community Sport Tool Kit. Both reference all are under their State/Territory jurisdictions.
- The current Public Health Orders remain in place until June 29
- The current Public Health Orders do not prevent any sporting organisation from resuming training.
- NSW State Sporting Organisations can start training immediately as long as they comply with the current Public Health Orders, including training in maximum groups of 10 people and following the recommended physical distancing measures of 1.5metres & 4sqm per person.
- We are currently working with TFA, QTF and Dr Paul Griffin Director of Infectious Diseases at Mater Health to develop a return to playing Touch Football Protocol.





Localised Return to Play Planning

- Consider how you will handle sign on sheets to avoid gathering
- How you can set your club house up for social distancing
- Consider how to possibly reconfigure the canteen facility for social distancing
- Can you alter the layout of fields to avoid interaction
- Look at manipulating game times/formats to give greater breaks between games
- Can you have different entry and exit points
- Start considering how to implement a ball sanitising process
- Consider Committee wearing rubber gloves when on duty
- Already advised on no sub box but consider if practical allowing teams to sub from behind the deadball line
- Have Sanitiser available for members- encourage to bring their own
- Ensure only one referee to mark the card
- COVIDSafe Officer similar to MPIO





Return to Training Protocols

PREPARATION

1. You **MUST** keep an attendance record
2. Only One group per half field
3. Changerooms & showers **MUST** remain closed
4. Toilets open with soap and sanitiser
5. Participants to arrive 5 min prior to training dressed ready to train. If early stay in the car. Shower with soap pre and post training.
6. Parents are only to watch from their vehicle
7. Leave immediately following training
8. Conduct post training debriefs/teams discussions via video link
9. All Water bottles **MUST** be individually labelled and not shared
10. Participants to bring individual hand sanitiser to be used pre, during, post training. All equipment **MUST** be sanitised post session.
11. Social Distance protocols **MUST** be adhered to

Return to Training Protocols

HEALTH



1. If you feel unwell, do not attend training and you must seek medical clearance before returning
2. If you have had contact in the past 14 days with a known or suspected case of COVID-19 you must not attend training & seek medical clearance before returning
3. All suspected cases must be reported

4. Encourage COVIDSafe download by participants



YOU CAN



1. Training to be conducted in groups of no more than 10-coach/s included
2. A coach can only work with one group not across multiple groups
3. Social distancing of 1.5m
4. Spacing of 1 person per 4 sq metres
5. Non-contact skills/drills-fitness, agility individual ball skill, limited passing



YOU CAN NOT



1. Contact to contact drills
2. Activities with more than 10 persons
3. NO Spitting
4. NO Sharing Bottles
5. NO Sharing Towels
6. DO NOT congregate on or off the field
7. DO NOT use change rooms or showers





NSWTA Representative Events

- We are continuing to plan for Vawdon Cup, Country Championships and State Cup
- We will be governed by the NSW Public Health Orders, any NSW Government regulations, protocols around return to play and public gatherings along with our members and participants safety
- For 2020 our events likely will look and be run differently to than what people are used to due to the abovementioned. We will need everyone's patience and assistance in this area.
- Event staff are working on a number of scenarios to be considered.
- Once a return to play date is known- those scenarios and variations to playing conditions can be put into action.





Staffing and Strategic Planning

- NSWTA Staff are still working remotely.
- We are monitoring the advice from the relevant health departments and health authorities around transmission of COVID-19.
- All staff are on reduced hours. 10 staff are working 3 days and 4 staff four days.
- The Board has been working on the new Strategic Plan from the information provided via stakeholder engagements.
- The full body of work has been parked with the Board focusing on our COVID-19 Response and Recovery for the remainder of 2020.

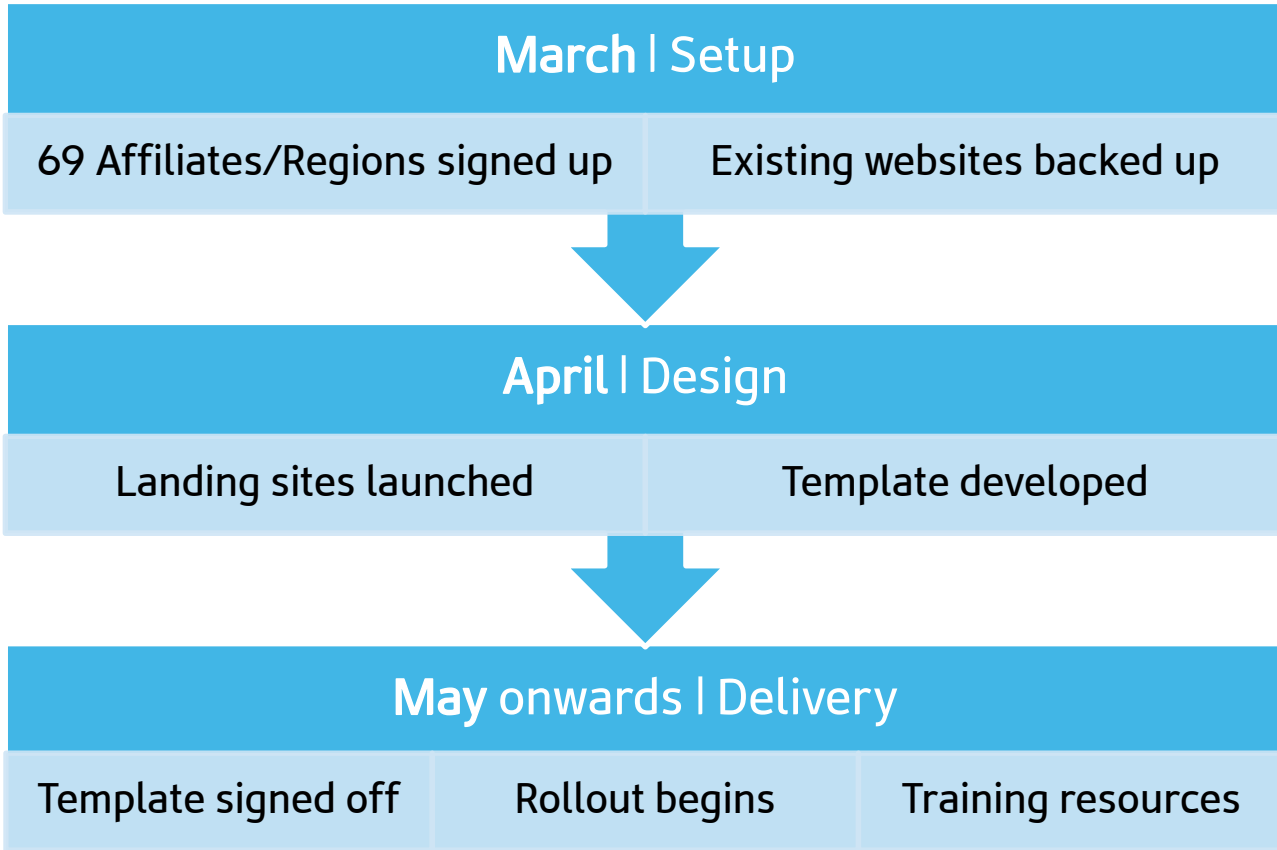




NSWTA Affiliate Website Rollout


- Aligned and scalable across the network
- \$15 per month for hosting for website URL e.g. temora.nswtouch.com.au
- Each Affiliate will be provided with a template website with generic wording and layout and content featuring their own custom colours and branding
- Once each Affiliate has their template will be able to copy and paste previous info from backed up website OR 'start fresh' using generic template
- Front end or back end editor functions depending on your needs/capability
- Access to analytics to understand usage

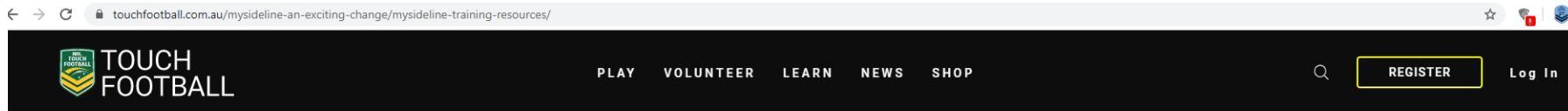



PLAN FOR THE TRANSFER OF COMPETITION DATA INTO MYSIDELINE

<https://touchfootball.com.au/mysideline-an-exciting-change/competition-data-transfer/>

- COVID-19 delayed the transfer of active and historic competition data into the new system (including teams and player stats)
- Not knowing if Touch Football competitions would be able to operate has complicated the mapping of data
- Transferring active competition data that will then need to be reconfigured due to a changed competition approach (refixturing, regrading, different teams playing) would increase administrative burden unnecessarily.
- Could be easier to manipulate draws (with changes to teams, round numbers, dates, etc) out of platform and uploaded using MySideline's Draw Importer, rather than administrators having to take 'old' fixtures that have been transferred
- The competition data transfer has been scheduled to be completed by mid-June, TFA in collaboration with the relevant state office will make decisions around the best approach – pending Return to Play date





SO WHAT CAN I DO IN MYSIDELINE NOW?

- Review the training materials and setup your association and a competition
- Run a contact report and prepare your communications to your participants
- The registration portal went live on Monday - www.touchfootball.com.au or www.touchfootball.com.au/nsw
- People can now find comps and teams to register in via The Finder
- **Registering a team.** Team contacts will register their team via the Finder
- Once a team is registered, **individual players** will be able to find that team to register to via the finder or a link from their contact
- **Close competitions if no return-to-play date**
- **Expressions of Interest.** If someone finds a competition through the Finder but the competition is closed, a GET IN CONTACT button will appear so they can submit an EOI
- Start to get familiar with MySideline. Support resources are within the platform
- NSWTA is planning a specific online session in early June with MSCs
