	<p>Closing date for Referee and Team nomination is Sunday 15th November, 2020.</p> <p>All successfully nominated Affiliates will be required to provide their Team Rosters by Monday, 16th November, 2020. Please send via email to ben.williams@nswtouch.com.au</p> <p>Incomplete Team, Coach and Referee Nominations will be advised to Affiliates and only accepted when properly completed in accordance to the requirements.</p>
2.2	Nominations and Entry Fees
	<p>Affiliate Team and Referee Nominations: will be available through the link below;</p> <p>State Cup Nomination Form and are due by Sunday 15th November 2020.</p> <p>There are a number of important details that are necessary for this process to be completed;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Teams the Affiliate are entering into the competition.• Qualified Referees for each team and details (Name, Mobile and Email), plus one additional referee from your Affiliate (For Example 2 teams/3 Referees)• No nomination for a Referee who will be Referee Coaching at the event and will not be refereeing will be accepted• No nomination for a Referee who currently sits on the Panel and will not be refereeing will be accepted <p>Team Registration: Once nominations (Referees and Team Numbers) are confirmed by the Events Team for compliance, the Affiliate Coordinator will be sent the Team's Registration Link.</p> <p>The Affiliate Coordinator will need to complete this process which requires all Team Management Details (Name/Mobile/Email) by 5pm Sunday 15th November 2020</p> <p>Team Bond: A bond of \$200 per team will be payable on the nomination. The Bond will be returned post-event should the nomination proceed unabated. Should a team be nominated and then withdrawn, the bond will not be returned. 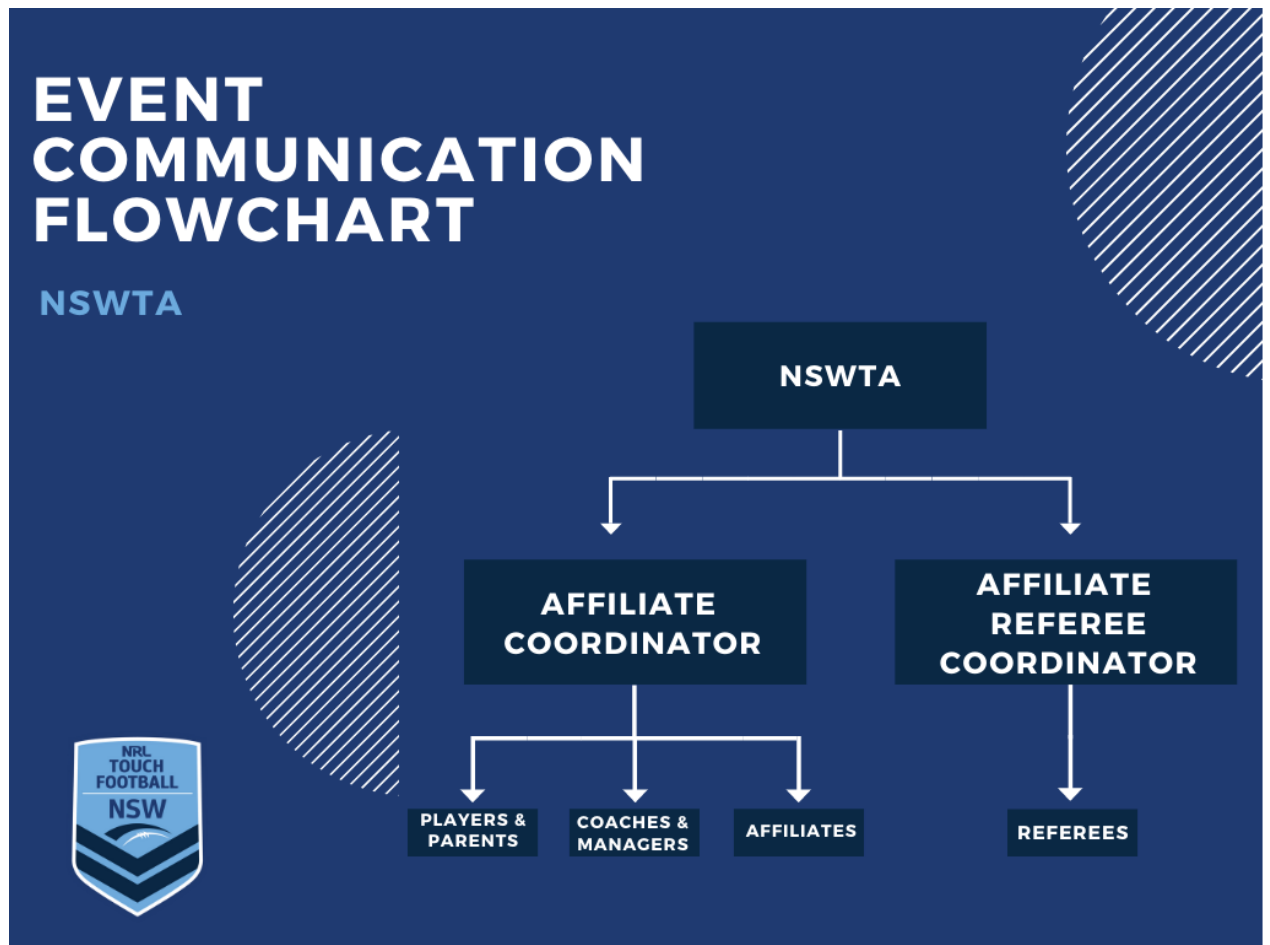

	<p>The Venue for the 2020 State Cup will be The Regional Sporting Complex Boundary Street and Tuffins Lane Playing Fields, Tuffins Lane – Port Macquarie.</p> <p>N.B. Due to the need to revise the traffic management plan due to the conditions of play and the Arrive Play Leave protocol, details of access to areas of the venue will be released closer to the event.</p>																		
2.6	<h3>Affiliate Coordinator and Team Management Requirements</h3>																		
	<p>Affiliate Coordinators and Team Management personnel must be members and registered within the NSWTA Affiliate they represent, in the current or previous competition.</p> <p>Each Affiliate will be allowed to have one Affiliate Coordinator who will be deemed as part of the NSW Officials. This person will have access to all Zones. The Affiliate coordinator must be the same person for the whole weekend. They will always need to be on site to aid in dealing with any issues with their Affiliate.</p>																		

	<p>We would ask that you advise us of your affiliate coordinator no later than Friday, November 13. PARTICIPATES IN AN UNAFFILIATED COMPETITION, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THEY ALSO PLAY IN AN AFFILIATE COMPETITION, THEY WILL BE INELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN A NSWTA OR TFA TOURNAMENT FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS".</p>
2.7	Referee Nomination
	<p>The referee nomination must be completed as part of the team nomination process which is due on Sunday 15th November 2020.</p> <p>Affiliate Responsibilities of Referee Nominations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Affiliates are required to nominate as a minimum of one (1) referee per team nominated PLUS one (1) Extra Referee by 5pm Sunday 15th November 2020. This equates to one additional referee compared to that of teams the Affiliate has entered. i.e.: 3 teams = 4 Referees • Nominated referees must be officiating at the Affiliate they wish to represent • Nominated referees must be of the standard of the State Cup competition • Nominated referees must have at least 12 months of practical refereeing experience before attending the State Cup <p>Referee Responsibilities of Nomination:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be 16 years or older • Must have a minimum of Level 2 Referees accreditation. • Be available all three days of the competition • Referees already attending as Panel and will not be officiating will not be included as clubs numbers

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete the individual referee’s registration by Wednesday 18th of November. • Referees cannot be Playing, Coaching, Managing, Selecting or involved in any other capacity. All Referees first priority must be refereeing games they are appointed to. <p>If the referee’s nomination is not completed team nominations will be rejected. During the verification process, if a referee is unaware that they have been nominated by the Affiliate, the Affiliates team nominations will not be accepted.</p> <p>Referee eligibility:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nominated Referees must be participating in the current Affiliate they wish to represent. We acknowledge that NSWTA’s rules and regulations have not been sternly enforced enough in the past in relation to Referee movements compared to players and this is now monitored by the events teams. If no evidence is shown that the nominated Referee participates at the nominated club the Events Team will seek a replacement. If no replacement the nominated team linked to the Referee will be withdrawn. <p>Referees without a Team wanting to attend State Cup: - \$295.00 for Referees requiring accommodation. \$420.00 for an interstate Referee requiring accommodation. Or \$270.00 for an interstate Referee not requiring accommodation</p>
2.8	Individual On-Line Registration
	<p>The individual registration process will be open and available via MySideLine once the nominations have been confirmed by the NSWTA Event Coordinator.</p> <p>The fees for the 2020 State Cup are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individual Players Registration: \$115.00 incl. GST per player. <p>Refunds: Any player that withdraws will be in consideration for a full refund of registration. This must be via written correspondence to the Competitions Coordinator by Friday 11th December, no applications will be accepted after Friday 18th December 2020.</p>
2.9	Team Numbers
	<p>Teams may register a maximum of fourteen (14) players in the event. Upon protest, any team found guilty of either using more than fourteen (14) players or using an unregistered player may be liable to be disqualified. All teams as a minimum MUST register a minimum of fourteen (14) Players.</p> <p>N.B A player may only register in one (1) team.</p> <p>All teams and Affiliates that do not register the required 14 players for each team will be invoiced for the shortfall of players at \$115.00 per player to make up to and including the 14 players required.</p>
2.10	Communication
	<p><u>Enquiries for all teams must be made by the Affiliate Coordinator.</u></p> <p>Each Affiliate must appoint an Affiliate Coordinator. All correspondence and dealings must be made through the Affiliate Coordinator. All communication with Affiliates and Teams will be done with the email address provided.</p>

To further enhance the communication links, it is recommended that all Affiliate Coordinators, Team Management, Players and Referees utilise the NSW Touch smart phone free app. This is available via the Google Play Store and Apple App Store.

It is the responsibility of the Affiliate Coordinator to ensure Coaches and Managers are informed of any changes when notified by NSWTA and that they are conversant with these Conditions of Entry and the General Conditions of Entry for all NSWTA Events.



2.11 Affiliate Coordinators and Team Management Briefing

3.6	Game duration
	<p>Round games will be 25 minute Touchdown Turn-around. The Final Series will be the same. In the event of a draw in the Final Series the drop off procedure will be used to decide the winner.</p>
3.7	Trophies
	<p>Awards will be presented to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medallions for the winners and runners up • Affiliate Championship • Finals Referees (Medallions only) • Player of the Final
3.8	Presentations
	All Presentations will be held on Sunday 6 th of December.
3.9	Draw Format
	The final format will not be decided until all team nominations are received.
3.10	Medical
	<p>The Medical Team will comprise of: Doctor, Physiotherapists and Sports Trainers</p> <p>Due to COVID-19, Public Health Order restrictions on public gathering the Medical team will NOT provide preventive strapping. They are only provided for the treatment of in game injuries in 2020.</p> <p>All preventative strapping is to take place prior to arrival at the venue.</p> <p>For insurance requirements, please report all injuries to the NSWTA Medical team and takeaway a copy of the incident report.</p>

3.11	Movement of Players between Divisions
	In this competition players are <u>unable</u> to move between divisions nor change teams within any Affiliate.
3.12	Finals Eligibility
	A player must have played a minimum of one (1) round game to be eligible for the final series. Any players not fulfilling the criteria due to extenuating circumstances must make written application to the Business Operations Manager for consideration.
3.13	Team Registration Forms
	<p>The official NSWTA Team Registration Forms must be submitted to the Events Officer via rebecca.dennis@nswtouch.com.au including player signatures and jersey numbers. This will only be accepted via document scanning It must be emailed by 5pm Friday 27th November.</p> <p>Non-Compliance Penalty: Failure to meet this timeline will result in the offending team starting the competition with a deduction of four (4) competition points. Additionally, the offending team will forfeit each game until the signed/jersey numbers corrected registration form is lodged.</p> <p>Players whom register late cannot be added to the registration form and will have a separate process.</p>
3.14	Rules, Variations and Adjustments
	<p>The NSWTA conduct events under the auspices of the Touch Football Australia 8th Edition rule book.</p> <p>Please refer to NSWTA Rules, Variations & Adjustments outlined as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Substitution and Sub Box – Due to current COVID-19 restrictions for the 2020 State Cup only, all substitutions can occur from the 7 metre to 7 metre line only after a substituted player has crossed the sideline. Please note that on occasions where teams share a sideline e.g. same sideline, adjoining fields etc that teams are mindful of social distancing. • Mutual Respect Policy – All participating members of the 2020 State Cup (including Players, Coaches, Referees, Selectors, Officials and spectators), have an obligation to be conversant with this protocol and both the NSWTA and TFA Member Protection Policy. This is explained in full detail under clause 12.4 in the General Conditions of Entry. <p>N.B. These can also be found under Section 12: Rules within the General Conditions of Entry.</p>
3.15	Send Offs
	<p>Any player sent from the field for the remainder of the game will receive an automatic two (2) match suspension unless the Judiciary or Disciplinary Committee considers further action.</p> <p>Any participant who receives two “periods of time” throughout the tournament (not in the same game), will also receive an Automatic one (1) match suspension. Every subsequent period of time will receive an automatic one (1) match suspension</p> <p>For more information please view the “General Conditions of Entry” and specifically sections 12.5. 12.6, 13</p>
